



Night Curfew

At Camp Koinonia we have a night curfew of 10pm. At this point everyone should be back in their cabins with minimum noise as we are part of a residential community with neighbour who have the right to a peaceful night’s sleep as well as other campers and camp staff.

Camp Koinonia policy for our night curfew is that a group’s representative is to be responsible for the night curfew – Night Watchman, from 10pm to 6am ensuring all group members are in their cabins unless using the bathroom facilities and all noise is at a minimum.

The Night Watchman is to do regular patrols of site and detect and control any situation that arises during the curfew time.

The Night Watchmen must be nominated and camp staff are to have their contact name and phone number so contact can be made if any situations arise.

If you do not have a representative to carry out these tasks a professional guard can be organised at the cost to your group. Approximately \$300 per night.

If your group Night Watchmen is unable to complete their tasks a security guard will be organised for the following night/s at the cost of the group.
